## **Honor Flight Rochester Application FAQ**

# **Where Can I Get An Application?**

Veteran and Guardian Applications may be completed and submitted on-line at www.HonorFlightRochester.org. You may also download and print both applications or request to have a paper version of either or both applications mailed to you by visiting us at www.HonorFlightRochester.org.

You may also pick-up paper versions of either application at any Town Hall in Monroe County.

# **How Many Applications Must I complete?**

A WWII Veteran needs to complete only the *Veteran Application*. The *Guardian Application* is for a person (typically a family member other than a spouse) who is interested in accompanying the Veteran on the Honor Flight to assist the Veteran.

If you do not have a friend or family member able to travel with the Veteran, that is okay. We have hundreds of volunteers, one of whom will be assigned to travel with your WWII Veteran as a Guardian on his or her flight. Therefore, the Veteran must complete the Veteran Application and, if you have a Guardian able to join the Veteran, then please have him or her complete the Guardian application.

#### **How Much Will It Cost?**

There is no cost to WWII veterans. The full cost (including air fare, meals, snacks, and hotel) is covered by Honor Flight Rochester, Inc. However, we do ask for a \$300 contribution from Guardians to help defray the costs associated with their trip expenses.

## When Will I Go On A Flight?

We typically make six flights per year between April and October. WWII Veterans generally fly in the order in which their applications are received. Medical priorities are the exception to that rule.

The Veteran will be informed of which flight he or she will be on approximately six weeks prior to that scheduled flight date. This means that you may not hear about the flight date for 6-12 months after submitting your application. But with hundreds of local WWII Veterans currently in line, please submit your application now in order to be considered for future flights.
